

NOW THEREFORE THIS DECLARATION OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

This TRUST DEED is made on the Third day of October, Two Thousand Seven (03-16-2007), BETWEEN Mr. Laxman K. Mohanty, S/o Late S. N. Mohanty, aged about 44 years, presently residing at Plot No 405/2291, Patla, Bhubaneswar-751031 (hereinafter called as "SETTLER")- party of the First Part,

WHEREAS the settler is desirous of creating a public charitable trust in respect of the sum of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) in the manner hereinafter appearing.

AND WHEREAS the trustees have consented to act as the first and founder trustees of these presents and to accept the trust under these presents as testified by their being parties to and executing the same.

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AND WHEREAS the said sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only), in anticipation of deed of Trust, has already been transferred, paid and handed over to the trustees before the execution of this deed of trust.

And whereas the TRUSTEES have agreed to carry out the trust herein created.

Now this TRUST DEED witnesseth as follows:

1.0 NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE TRUST

The trust shall be called Future Focus Initiative and its registered office for the time being shall be at Plot No. 36/1, Chandaka Industrial Estate, Patia, Bhubaneswar-751024.

2.0 OFFICE OF THE TRUST

The principal office of the Trust shall be located in Bhubaneswar. Trust may also open or operate branch office or offices or working office or offices elsewhere.

The board of trustees shall have the powers to change the address of the office and in the event of any change in the address; a written notice of such change shall be given to all the concerned authorities within 30 days of such change.

- 3.0 INTERPRETATION: In this Declaration, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or the context.
- a) "The Income Tax Act", means the Income Tax Act, 1961, (Act 43 of 1961) for the time being in force and any statutory modification or replacement thereof, and references to such sections of the modified or replaced Act as correspond to the sections of the Income Tax Act.
- b) "Public Trusts Act" means the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 for the time being in force, or any statutory modification or replacement thereof.
- c) "Charitable Purpose" means and includes relief of the poor, education, medical relief and the advancement of any object of general public utility not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit.
- d) "Corpus" of the Trust Fund means the sum of Rs.1000/-(Rupees One Thousand Only) settled on the Trustees before the execution of these presents, and such further sums of moneys or properties that the Trustees may receive or accept as donations towards Corpus under the terms thereof, and the sums transferred from the income of the Trust Fund to the Corpus under Clause (3) thereof, and the investments for the time being of all sums, moneys and properties constituting the corpus.
- e) "Income" of the Trust means all accretions of the Trust Fund not being accretions to the Corpus of the Trust Fund; provided however, that any surplus arising on the sale, exchange, relinquishment or compulsory acquisition or other transfer whatsoever, of any assets of the Trust Fund and Bonus shares received in respect of investment in Shares shall be considered an accretion to Corpus.
- f) "Trustees" means the Trustees for the time being of the Trust and includes the Permanent Trustees, and the Trustees appointed hereunder in substitution of the First Trustees.
- g} "Year" means the period from 1st April to 31st March of next year.
- h) The trustees shall stand possessed of the Trust Funds and the properties of the Trust, upon trust to receive the income of the trust and other accretions to the Trust Fund, and to apply the net income of the Trust. (that is to say, the gross income of

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the Trust after deducting there from the expenses incidental to the management of the Trust or of the Trust properties, or the expenses of or relating to the carrying out the purposes of the Trust) or a part of such net income to the public charitable purposes of the trust and to accumulate (to the extent prescribed by these presents) the whole or a part of such net income for application to such purposes.

4.0 TRUST FUND

The trustees do declare that they, the trustees, shall hold and stand possessed of the sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) hereinafter referred to as "the trust fund" upon the trust and subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter appearing and contained of and concerning the same.

The trust fund shall, unless repugnant to the subject or context, also include any other property and investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof may be converted, invested or varied, from time to time, and those which may be acquired by the trustees or come to their hands by virtue of these presents, including all contributions either in cash or other properties, movable or immovable, which may be received by the trustees, from time to time, from any person or persons, any institution or institutions for the purposes of these presents.

5.0 OBJECTS

The objects of the Trust are -

- (a) To establish, maintain and/or support schools, colleges, including medical, dental, pharmacy, nursing colleges, or other educational institutions for Arts, Science, Medicine, Commerce, Engineering & Technology, Bioscience, Management or other branches of knowledge, and to establish maintain or grant free studentship, scholarship, prizes or other aid or stipends for students and for research workers.
- (b) To provide primary, secondary school education to the young students in accordance with the provisions contained in the Indian Constitution and other connected laws of the central and state governments and run and supervise educational institutions that help-children to grow as complete human beings in terms of skills, attitude and behaviour.
- (c) To establish and manage rural technical schools to provide vocational training to rural children, to train villagers on various appropriate technologies and run income generation programs that may provide training to students and villagers, contribute towards the resources of the schools and act as role models for the community.
- (d) To run non-formal link schools that can extend literacy among illiterate groups
- (e) To establish focused centers to provide teachers' training, career counseling, psychometric testing and other services that will be useful to students, teachers and parents.
- (f) To set up entities to promote handicrafts and alternative health practices and products
- (g) To carry out, promote, aid, manage and support the activity of studies and research in multi-disciplinary subjects affecting welfare and development of people including developmental planning & management, social sciences, science and technology, fine arts, environment, natural resources, health, education, housing, infrastructure etc. which shall help in understanding and addressing the issues in more systemic, scientific and comprehensive way.

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- (w) To give donations, grants-in-aid or other contributions to other trusts, or institutions for the purposes enumerated from (a) to (v) above, provided that the trust or institution fulfills the conditions mentioned in section 80G(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961; and to give donations or contributions to the National Defence Fund, Jawaharlal Nehru Memorial Fund or other National and Charitable Funds promoted by the Central or State Governments.
- (x) And to do all such other things that are conducive to and necessary for fulfilling the objects of the Trust.

6.0 DECLARATION OF THE TRUST

That for effecting the said desires with effect from the Twenty third (23) Day of April, Two Thousand Four (2004), the said trust fund of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) is available for the use by the TRUSTEES as absolute owners upon Trust and to be administered according to the rules, regulations and provisions herein contained.

7.0 NUMBER OF TRUSTEE

The minimum number of trustees shall be SEVEN and the maximum number of trustees shall not exceed FIFTEEN.

8.0 BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- a. The MANAGING TRUSTEE shall be the permanent trustee Mr. Ramananda Mishra during his lifetime. Provided further that, in case he ceases to be a trustee in the circumstances as enumerated in clause (10) of this deed, the trustees may elect any one of the remaining trustee to be Managing Trustee of the Board of Trustees.
- b. Mr. Ramananda Mishra, aged about 44 years, S/o Pitamber Mishra, residing at Alamchand Bazar, Cuttack-753002, shall hold the office of Managing Trustee.
- c. All the Founder Trustees together shall form the Board of Trustees and shall together govern the affairs and funds of the Trust according to the terms of this Trust deed. The total number of Trustees shall be a minimum of five and a maximum of thirty.
- d. The Board of Trustees may take new people as trustees till the maximum number is not reached.
- e. If at any time, during his/her trusteeship, the Managing Trustee tenders his/her resignation, or becomes incapable to discharge his/her duties, other trustees will nominate a person to be the Managing Trustee.

9.0 NOMINATION OF TRUSTEE TO TRUST BOARD

The BOARD OF TRUSTEES may co-opt such other persons as trustees as they think fit, so as to increase their number not exceeding the maximum number of trustees. The trustees may from time to time nominate such other person as trustees to fill in vacancies or nominate additional trustees not exceeding the maximum number.

10.0 POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all money received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in the course of management of Trust funds/properties or in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purposes of the trust as well as all assets and credits of the Trust properties. With the provisions of the Income-tax Act, for the investment or use of trust funds, for the time being in force, the Board of Trustees will have the following powers:

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- The management and administration of the Trust shall vest in the Board of Trustees.
- a. The Funds of the Trust shall be invested in bank deposits, government bonds or such other appropriate securities as the board of Trustees may decide.
- b. The board shall have power to borrow money for the purposes of the Trust. For all kinds of financial transactions the Managing Trustee is empowered to sign any instrument as may be necessary.
- c. The Managing Trustee shall have overall power of superintendence over the affairs of the Trust and shall have in particular the power to operate bank accounts, borrow money for the Trust and carry out objects of the Trust.
- d. The Managing Trustee may authorise any of the Trustees to act on his/her behalf and to operate bank accounts.
- e. Board of Trustees may constitute several committees to promote various activities of the trust and invite outsiders as part of the members of those committees. These members can be removed from the committees at any time on the discretion of the Board.
- f. To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or kind from any person, body or body of persons or trust, with or without conditions.
- g. To apply the whole or part of the income of the Trust Fund or accumulation thereof to any one or more of the objects of the trust as the Trustees may in their discretion from time to time determine.
- To sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property as necessary for the purpose of the Trust.
- To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the trustees and committees or administrators) for the purpose of the administration of the trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Board of Trustees may from time to time think fit.
- The Board of Trustees can also remove any employee or any appointee whose services are not required by the Trust.

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For the removal of doubts it is hereby declared that this Trust, its objects and ts implementations shall not be for the benefit of any particular caste or religious community as such.

11.0 PAYMENT TO THE TRUSTEES

- a. The trustees may reimburse themselves and pay and discharge out of the trust funds or money in their hands, for all the expenses incurred for execution of the said trust deed.
- b. It is expressly agreed that the trustees shall be entitled to be paid their actual expenses for travel, boarding and lodging, or any other bonafide expense, which may be incurred by them in the performance of their duties as trustees.
- c. Any trustee, for the time being, engaged in carrying on the execution of the activities of the said trust, over and above his/her responsibilities as trustee, may be paid reasonable remuneration if the Board of Trustees, so decide.
- d. Any trustee, for the time being an advocate, engineer or any person carrying on any profession shall be entitled to charge and be paid all his/ her usual professional and other charges for the business carried out by him/ her firm in relation to the trust.

12.0 MEETINGS AND PROCEEDINGS

- a. In each meeting the activities of the Trust shall be reviewed and decisions be taken. The proceedings of the meeting shall be minuted by the Managing Trustee and once confirmed the same shall be final and binding.
- The Trustees may meet as often they deem fit, but normally a period of twelve months should not elapse without holding at least one meeting.
- A meeting shall be called for by the Managing Trustee and the quorum for all the meetings shall be a minimum of five trustees.
- d. The Managing Trustee shall preside over all the meetings of the Trust. In case the Managing Trustee is not present, s/he may depute one of the trustees to preside the meeting in his/her absence.
- A resolution passed without any meeting of the trustees and signed by all the trustees shall be effectual as a resolution duly passed at a meeting of the trustees held in accordance with these present.
- f. A resolution in writing circulated among all the trustees and approved by a three-fourth majority of the total number of trustees shall be as effective and binding as if the resolution has been passed at a regular meeting of the trustees duly called or convened.

Unless otherwise stated in this declaration, or prescribed by the rules and regulation framed by the trustees, all decisions of the trustees shall be taken by a simple majority of the trustees present and voting. In case of a tie, the managing trustee shall have a casting vote in addition to his/her ordinary vote:

13.0 DISQUALIFICATION

If any Trustee becomes bankrupt or insane or is found guilty by a court of an offence involving moral turpitude, he/she shall ipso facto cease to be a trustee.

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14.0 DISQUALIFICATION OF TRUSTEE

The office of a trustees shall be vacated, and the person shall cease to be a trustee in the following event, namely;

- (a) if he/she dies.
- (b) if he/she becomes insane, or is otherwise incapable of acting as trustee.
- (c) if he/she adjudged as an insolvent or applied to be adjudged as an insolvent
- (d) if he/she remains absent from all the meetings of the trustees held during any year, without obtaining leave of absence.
- (e) if he/she resigns from his office, by notice in writing to the Board of Trustees.
- (f) If he/she is convicted of any offence or otherwise found to be guilty of any offence for which he/she is punishable or found to have been guilty as a trustee of the Trust of any fraud, misfeasance in relation to the Trust or Trust property or of any breach of his/her duty as a Trustee of the Trust.
- (g) if other trustees unanimously resolve that he/she ceases being a trustee

Provided however, that the permanent trustees shall not vacate for the reasons or in the events mentioned in sub-clause (d) and (g) hereof.

15.0 DISCHARGE FROM DUTY .

Any Trustee can cease to be a trustee by giving a written letter to that effect and on being accepted by the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees also can remove a trustee on 4/5 majority if the Board of Trustees feel that a particular trustee is acting against the interest of the trust.

16.0 DIFFERENCE OF OPINION

If any difference of opinion shall arise among the trustees as to the execution of the trust hereof or in exercise of the powers, authority and discretion herein contained or in any other matter arising out of or in relation to the trust hereby declared, the same shall be settled and disposed of in accordance with the opinion of the majority of the trustees The opinion of the majority of the trustees shall be final and binding on all the trustees. In the event of the trustees being equally divided, the Managing Trustee shall have an additional or casting vote.

17.0 INDEMNITY FOR THE TRUSTEES

The trustee(s) shall in no case be liable for any loss to the Trust unless the trustee(s) is (are) guilty of fraud.

The trustees shall be respectively chargeable only for such moneys and securities as they shall respectably actually receive and shall respectably be answerable and responsible only for their own acts, receipts, omission, neglects and defaults and not for those of each other, nor for any banker, broker, auctioneer or other persons with whom or into whose hands any trust money or

securities shall be deposited nor for the insufficiency of the title or deficiency in value of any investments nor for any other loss unless the same shall happen through their own willful default respectably.

18.0 ACCOUNTS AUDIT AND REPORTING

The Managing Trustee shall cause to maintain the correct and true accounts of all incomes, expenditures, assets and liabilities of the trust. The cash and bank () transaction and all the other financial transactions of the trust shall be recorded and maintained in accordance with the normally accepted accounting principle.

- It shall be the duty and responsibility of the Managing Trustee to see that the accounts of the Trust are prepared in accordance with the normal accounting procedures and that the accounts are audited by the auditors within 6 months from the date of closing of the financial year. The auditors shall be appointed by the Board of Trustees upon such terms and conditions as may be determined by the Board of Trustees.
- The Managing Trustee shall present the audited account together with the auditor's report to the Board of Trustees. He/she shall also present an annual report of the activities of the Trust to the Board of Trustees. The Managing Trustee will also get the budget for the coming year approved by the Board of Trustees.

19.0 BYELAWS, ADMINISTRATIVE RULES ETC.

In order to effectively function and to perform its role, the Board of Trustees without prejudice to the objects and spirit of the trust may from time to time make such bylaws, administrative rules, etc. as they deem fit. It shall also have powers, to amend, to repeal and modify its byelaws and rules. The byelaws, rules etc. can in no case be violated of the covenants of this Trust deed.

20.0 AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE TRUST, EXTENSION AND MERGER

With a resolution of only 4/5th majority of the Board of Trustees the following matters shall be effective and the Trustees shall have the powers to do the following acts:

- Any clause of this Trust deed can be amended (including the name of the trust) in so far it does not affect the main objects as well the spirit behind the conduct and the management of the trust.
- Any other trust with similar objects can be merged with this trust provided the merger does not adversely affect the activities of the trust financially or otherwise.
- In the event of the extinction of the trust after meeting its liabilities, the balance of the properties, funds, etc. shall be transferred to any other trust, society, or institutions with objects similar to that of the trust
- 21.0 The trustees shall be entitled to modify any of the clauses of this declaration of trust, including the duties and powers of trustees, provided however that the modifications so made shall not affect the nature or character of the trust as a trust for public charitable purposes and benefits are not restricted or confined to any particular religious community or caste.
- 22.0 This is a PUBLIC REGISTERED TRUST. It is irrevocable. The properties of the trust shall in no way revert to the founder or any other Trustee(s), in any case, whether on merger or extinction.
- 23.0 The trust is irrevocable and in any case whether on merger or extinction no part of the funds, properties shall be distributed among the trustees.

24.0 No part of the trust fund, either the corpus or the income there from, or from any other sources, shall be utilised for any purpose other than that of the Trust hereby. created.
